To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, There is now deposited in the Bureau of Land Management of the United States, a Certificate of the Land Office at Marquette, Michigan, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress of May 20, 1862, "To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Angeline Wab-nin-kee, widow of John Wab-nin-kee, has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the following described land:

Michigan Meridian, Michigan.

T. 38 N., R. 10 W.,

Sec. 18, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$.

The area described contains 80 acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, on file in the Bureau of Land Management.

WHEREAS, an Order of the authorized officer of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, dated June 21, 1954, directed that a patent issue to the purchaser, Kenneth W. Greene, for said tract:

NOW KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States, unto the said Kenneth W. Greene, the Tract of land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Kenneth W. Greene, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, the undersigned authorized officer of the Bureau of Land Management, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of June 17, 1948 (62 Stat., 476), has, in the name of the United States, caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the Bureau to be hereunto affixed.
