To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, an Order of the Secretary of the Interior has been deposited in the General Land Office, directing that a fee simple patent issue to the claimant Frank Ahshahgushe, a Chippewa Indian, for the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section thirteen in Township forty-seven north of Range twenty west of the Michigan Meridian, Michigan, containing forty acres:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said claimant and to the heirs of the said claimant the Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant forever. The land covered by this patent is not liable for any debt contracted prior to this date, as provided by Section 5 of the Act of February 8, 1887 (24 Stat. 388, 389), and the amendatory Acts of May 8, 1906 (34 Stat., 182) and June 21, 1906 (34 Stat., 325, 327). This patent is issued in lieu of Patent No. 748188, dated May 7, 1920, which has been canceled because of an error in the name of the patentee.
